First Year Programs

Among other services our Department of Student Success offers, certain special programs for first year students are rolled out. Housed within the Office of First Year and Family Programs, these include but are not limited to Habib University's Orientation Program and First Year Success program, both of which are meant to help students make the move to the University.

New Student Orientation (NSO) – Unlike other orientations, which begin a few days before the beginning of classes, we start our orientation the summer before. This allows for more time to assist students in improving and retaining material presented at the orientation.

First Year Success – This special program offers students the skills needed to excel at the University and beyond. The First Year Success program completes each year with a mandatory service-learning project for all first year students.

Learning Communities

Once you are admitted to Habib University, you will be assigned to a small team of your fellow students. These unique cohorts of students are meant for you to develop an appreciation for diversity. Your group will function as a learning community, within which you will experience your three year Liberal Core experience. As a group, you will meet each week to attend faculty and/or mentor facilitated discussions surrounding topics raised in readings and weekly lectures. Habib University Admissions /

Admissions to Habib University are solely based on merit and are regardless of gender, culture, ethnicity, national origin, religion, or even socio-economic background. Our process is a holistic one. We evaluate each application individually with the following guidelines in mind:

- Academic potential (transcripts, board exam results, entrance test or SAT scores, and academic achievements)
- Intellectual, creative and personal pursuits and passions (co-curricular/extra-curricular involvement and interests)
 - Writing competencies (personal essay, short answer responses, and writing section on entrance test)

How to Apply

We are running an online application process. To apply for admissions at Habib University, you will be required to:

- Sign up at Habib University for an account with a valid email address
- Complete the online application
- Pay the application fee online or send us a copy of payment receipt
- Upload the checklist of documents
- Submit the application with supporting documents and fees before February 2, 2014
- Appear for the Entrance Test (1st round shortlisted applicants only)
- Appear for the Interview at the Designated Time & Location (2nd round shortlisted applicants only)

Financial Aid and Scholarship /

Habib University is committed to making quality education affordable to all. We have made a commitment to meet the demonstrated need of all or our students. Our Financial Aid and Scholarship program provides students with merit based scholarships, need based grants, work study and facilitated student loans. Financial aid applications are available and can be sent to you at your request. Financial aid applications are due no later than February 17.

Types of Aid

At Habib University, a student's financial aid package includes one or more of the following types of assistance:

Grants: These are need-based funds that are awarded based on the financial aid application. Grants do not need to be repaid.

Student Employment Opportunities: Students may participate in Work Study Programs where they are employed on campus.

Loans: Habib University has made available to students both University student loans and facilitated student loans through our financial partners. Loans must be repaid according to the agreement signed with the loan provider.

Merit Scholarships: At Habib University, we offer a variety of merit-based scholarships. Most of these are awarded based on academic excellence. However since not all accomplishments can be measured in grades and test scores, scholarships are also available for outstanding athletes, performers, artists and leaders who have been involved in extracurricular activities.
